1 **FINAL JUDGMENT AS TO DEFENDANT CITY OF OXNARD**

2 Plaintiffs N.M.M, Z.G.M and M.H.M. by and through their Guardian Ad
3 Litem Luis Morado and Monique Wallace, filed a First Amended Complaint and
4 Defendant City of Oxnard having entered a general appearance; consented to the
5 Court’s jurisdiction over Defendant and the subject matter of this action; consented
6 to entry of this Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations of the
7 Complaint (except as to jurisdiction); waived findings of fact and conclusions of
8 law and waived any right to appeal from this Final Judgment:

9 (1.) On May 1, 2017 the Parties arrived at the general parameters of the
10 Settlement. An Unopposed Petition for Compromise of Minor’s Claims was filed
11 on June 1, 2017. On September 12, 2017, the Court granted Plaintiff minors’
12 Petition.

13 (2.) The Parties agreed to settle this entire action for [REDACTED] as to all
14 Plaintiffs. A total of [REDACTED] will be distributed evenly ([REDACTED]) to each
15 minor (minus attorneys’ fees and costs). \$100,000 would be paid to Monique
16 Wallace and her attorneys within thirty (30) days of entry of the Final Judgment.

17 (3.) Defendant shall make a payment in the amount of [REDACTED]
18 payable to [REDACTED] for the benefit of minor N.M.M within
19 thirty (30) days of entry of the Final Judgment.

20 (4.) Defendant shall make a payment in the amount of [REDACTED]
21 payable to [REDACTED] for the benefit of minor Z.G.M within
22 thirty (30) days of entry of the Final Judgment.

23 (5.) Defendant shall make a payment in the amount of [REDACTED]
24 payable to [REDACTED] for the benefit of minor M.H.M within
25 thirty (30) days of entry of the Final Judgment.

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1 (6.) Defendant shall make a payment in the amount of [REDACTED]
2 payable to Trust of Luis Morado within thirty (30) days of entry of the Final
3 Judgment.

4 (7.) Defendant shall make a payment in the amount of [REDACTED]
5 payable to trust account for *Douglas / Hicks Law, APC* and Sias | Carr, LLP within
6 thirty (30) days of entry of the Final Judgment.

7 (8.) Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), the
8 parties stipulate that defendant OFFICER ROGER GARCIA is dismissed with
9 prejudice from this action;

10 (9.) The parties further agree that this judgment constitutes a general
11 mutual release and a mutual waiver of all costs, court fees, and attorney's fees
12 arising out of litigation of all of plaintiffs' claims, known and unknown as to any
13 defendant, in accordance with the terms of the release and settlement agreement.

14 (8.) It is further ordered that the consent is incorporated here with the
15 same force and effect as if fully set forth here, and that Defendant shall comply
16 with all of the undertakings and agreements set forth above.

17 (9.) It is further ordered that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this
18 matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this Final Judgment.

19 (10.) There being no just reason for delay, pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the
20 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure, the Clerk is ordered to enter this Final Judgment
21 immediately and without further notice.
