Plaintiff is a California prisoner incarcerated at the California Men’s Colony (“CMC”) filed this pro se civil action against CMC officials for violating his rights at CMC. Venue for civil rights claims concerning the conditions of his confinement at Atascadero is therefore proper in the Central District. *See* 28 U.S.C. 1391.
