**Proceedings: (In Chambers) Order to Show Cause Re: Sanctions or Dismissal**

Pursuant to the Court's Order of May 30, 2017, the parties were required to complete a settlement conference before a mediator from the court's ADR Panel no later than August 30, 2017. (See Dkt. 35 at 2; Dkt. 21, Court's Order of August 30, 2016). If the case settled, the parties were required to file a Notice of Settlement no later than 24 hours after settlement. (See Court's Order of August 30, 2016 at 18). Otherwise, the parties were required to file a Status Report Re: Settlement no later than 48 hours after the settlement conference was complete. (See id.).

As of the filing date of this Order, neither a Notice of Settlement nor a Status Report Re: Settlement has been filed. (See, generally, Dkt.). Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT, no later than **September 7, 2017**, the parties shall show cause in writing why sanctions should not be imposed for failure to comply with the Court's Order of May 30, 2017. **Failure to submit a response to this Order by the deadline set forth above may result in the imposition of sanctions and/or dismissal of this action for lack of prosecution.** See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b); Link v. Wabash R.R. Co., 370 U.S. 626, 629-30, 82 S.Ct. 1386, 1388 (1962); Pagtalunan v. Galaza, 291 F.3d 639, 642 (9th Cir. 2002), cert. denied, 538 U.S. 909 (2003).

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
