The Court accepts and 21 adopts the findings, conclusions, and recommendations of the Magistrate Judge. 22 IT IS ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order, Petitioner 23 shall either: (a) elect to proceed on his exhausted claims by filing a "Notice of 24 Petitioner's Election to Proceed on only his Exhausted Claims and Consent to 25 Striking Unexhausted Claims;" or (b) elect to return to state court to exhaust his 26 unexhausted claims by filing a consent to dismissal of this action without prejudice. 27 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Petitioner elects to withdraw 28
