The Court has reviewed the Second Amended Complaint, records on file, and Report and Recommendation of U.S. Magistrate Judge, which recommends that the Court take judicial notice of Defendant Reynolds's Exhibit 1, grant Defendant's motion to dismiss, dismiss Plaintiff's false-arrest claim without leave to amend, and dismiss his false-imprisonment claim with leave to amend.
