1 In accordance with the Court’s order granting the Motion for Entry of Default  
2 Judgment brought by Plaintiff Brighton Collectibles, LLC (“Plaintiff”) filed and  
3 entered on February 21, 2017,

4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff is entitled to judgment against  
5 Defendant IPPO Jewelry Corp. (“Defendant”) as follows:

- 6 1. Defendant shall pay Plaintiff \$150,000 in statutory damages for its  
7 willful infringement of Plaintiff’s Love Affair Heart copyright, VA-1-929-791; and
- 8 2. Defendant shall pay Plaintiff \$6,600 in attorneys’ fees.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that IPPO Jewelry Corp. and all predecessors,  
10 successors and related companies, each of their present and former members,  
11 managers, employees, representatives and agents, and any and all other persons  
12 acting by, through, under, or in concert with them, are permanently enjoined from  
13 designing, manufacturing, importing, shipping, delivering, selling, marketing,  
14 displaying, advertising, or promoting any products that incorporate designs  
15 substantially similar to, or that could be confused with, Brighton’s copyrighted  
16 design known as the “Love Affair Heart,” Copyright No. VA 1-929-791 , as  
17 pictured below:
