That proposal does not comply with Ninth Circuit authority on the subject. See, e.g., Oliner v. Kontrabecki, 745 F.3d 1024, 1026 (9th Cir. 2014); Kamakana v. City & Cnty. of Honolulu, 447 F.3d 1172, 1179 (9th Cir. 2006).
- 2. Instead, a party seeking to file material under seal with the Court due to the provisions of this protective order must submit an appropriate <u>application</u> pursuant to Local Rule of Court 79-5.1 for the Court to consider on a case-by-case basis.
