Plaintiff's motion to remand is DENIED. While the notice of removal contains a technical deficiency – "residency" rather than "citizenship" is alleged – there is no dispute that Plaintiff is a citizen of California and Defendant is a citizen of a foreign state not admitted for permanent residency. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C. § 1332(a)(2). Therefore, the court has diversity jurisdiction.
