On December 12, 2017, a Stipulation was filed permitting Defendant until December 27, 2016 to file an answer. Dkt. 15. A second Stipulation was filed extending that date to January 12, 2017. Dkt. 16. An Order to Show Cause re Dismissal was filed on January 27, 2017, ordering Plaintiff either to: (i) respond in writing no later than February 10, 2017 as to why the matter should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution; or (ii) file an application for the entry of default as to Defendant Jobar International, Inc. There has been no response filed to the Order to Show Cause, nor has an application been filed as to the named Defendant.
