2 The Court, having granted Plaintiff Liberty Insurance Corporation’s
3 (“Liberty’s”) Motion for Entry of Default Judgment against Defendants Khaled K.
4 Almaleh aka Khaled Al Maleh aka Kal Maleh (collectively, “K. Almaleh”),
5 Stephanie Mason, and Robert Nelson (“Defendants”), and good cause appearing
6 therefore,

8 IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that judgment is
9 hereby entered in favor of Liberty and against Defendants K. Almaleh, Stephanie
10 Mason, and Robert Nelson. Liberty had, and has, no duty to defend or indemnify K.
11 Almaleh, or to pay any portion of his defense costs, in an underlying state court
12 lawsuit entitled *Stephanie Mason et al. v. Khaled Al Maleh, et al.*, in the Superior
13 Court for the State of California, County of Los Angeles, Case No. BC605894 (the
14 “Underlying Action.”) Liberty is entitled to immediately withdraw from the defense
15 of K. Almaleh in the Underlying Action. Liberty is also entitled to reimbursement
16 of \$3,428.05 for the defense costs it has incurred to date to defend K. Almaleh in the
17 Underlying Action. **The costs are recoverable from K. Almaleh only.**
