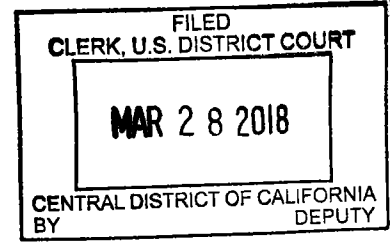

 20 Based upon the parties' Stipulation for the Award and Payment of Equal
 21 Access to Justice Act (EAJA) Fees and Costs, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff shall
 22 be awarded attorney fees under the EAJA in the amount of FOUR THOUSAND
 23 ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$4,150.00), and costs under 28 U.S.C.
 24 § 1920, in the amount of FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00), subject to the
 25 terms of the above-referenced Stipulation, to include the United States Department
 26 of the Treasury's Offset Program pursuant to *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 130 S.Ct. 2521
 27 (2010). Any payment shall be delivered to Plaintiff's counsel.
