Fed.R.Civ.Proc. 4(m). Generally, defendants must answer the complaint within 21 days after service (60 days if the defendant is the United States). Fed.R.Civ.Proc. 12(a)(1).

Accordingly, the court, on its own motion, orders plaintiff(s) to show cause in writing on or before <b>April 26, 2017</b> why this action should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution.
