3	i. Order that this action is dismissed without prejudice;
4	ii. Retain jurisdiction to vacate the dismissal order and reopen this action
5	within 180 days from the Notice of Settlement, unless, the parties request
6	that the Court retain jurisdiction for an additional period of time necessary
7	to finalize the settlement;
8	iii. The parties shall file a dismissal, with prejudice, upon the settlement being
9	finalized;
10	iv. If no dismissal with prejudice is filed at the end of the initial 180 day
11	period, or extended period, the parties shall appear for a status conference.
