17 On June 26, 2017, the Court granted Plaintiff Rafael Arroyo, Jr.’s Motion for
18 Default Judgment as to his claims under the Americans with Disabilities Act (“ADA”)
19 and the California Unruh Civil Rights Act (“Unruh”).

21 It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** as follows:

- 22
- 23 1. Defendants Ann J. Choi and JSK International, Inc. (collectively,
24 “Defendants”) are liable to Rafael Arroyo, Jr. for ADA and Unruh Act violations;
 - 25 2. Defendants are permanently enjoined from maintaining ADA-prohibited
26 barriers at their property, the APEX Gas Station in South Gate, California, and must
27 therefore remove all barriers identified in Arroyo’s Complaint to the extent permitted
28 under the lease or state law; and
