ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Based upon the Petition to Enforce Internal Revenue Service Summons, Memorandum of Points and Authorities, and supporting Declaration, the Court finds that Petitioner has established a prima facie case for judicial enforcement of the subject Internal Revenue Service (IRS) summons. See United States v. Powell, 379 U.S. 48, 57-58, 85 S.Ct. 248, 255 (1964). Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Respondent shall appear in Courtroom 6D of the First Street Courthouse at **10:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 20, 2017**, to show cause why the production of books, papers, records, and other data demanded in the subject IRS summons should not be compelled.

2. Plaintiff shall serve copies of the following documents on Respondent by personal delivery, by leaving a copy at Respondent's dwelling or usual place of abode with someone of suitable age and discretion who resides there, or by certified mail: (a) this Order; and (b) the Petition, Memorandum of Points and Authorities, and accompanying Declaration.
