Plaintiff alleges the Court has diversity jurisdiction. However, it fails to plead the citizenship of any of the parties correctly. A limited liability company is a citizen of the states of which each of its members is a citizen. See Johnson v. Columbia Props.

Anchorage, LP, 437 F.3d 894, 899 (9th Cir. 2006). No citizenship information is given for Plaintiff's members. Residence, rather than citizenship, is pleaded for the individual defendants. And the principal place of business for the corporate defendant is not
