13 WHEREAS, on April 10, 2017, Plaintiff PassKey Publications Licensing  
14 Corporation initiated the instant action against Coed Group, LLC, Kapli, Inc., and  
15 Plus Career, Inc. ("Defendants") for violations of the federal copyright laws, 17  
16 U.S.C. § 101, et seq.;

17 WHEREAS, Entry of Default was entered against Defendants on August 14,  
18 2017, and Default Judgment was entered against Defendants on November 7,  
19 2017;

20 WHEREAS, Plaintiff and Defendants have requested the Court to set aside  
21 the Entry of Default and Default Judgment;

22 WHEREAS, Defendants consent to the entry of Final Judgment on Consent;

23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

24 Plaintiff owns valid copyrights in the EA Materials as set forth in the  
25 Amended Complaint.

26 Defendants' conduct as set forth in the Amended Complaint constitutes  
27 infringement of Plaintiff's copyrights in its EA Materials.

1 Consent judgment is hereby entered as follows:

2 a. Consent judgment is hereby entered against Defendants for monetary  
3 relief in the amount set forth in the Parties' Confidential Settlement Agreement.

4 b. Each party shall bear its own attorneys' fees and costs.

5 c. Pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 502(a), Defendants, their agents, servants,  
6 employees, and licensees, successors and assigns, and all persons or entities in  
7 active concert or participation with any of them who receive notice of this Final  
8 Judgment on Consent, are hereby PERMANENTLY ENJOINED from  
9 reproducing, adapting, publishing, marketing, promoting, advertising, distributing,  
10 selling, and/or otherwise disposing of any materials, in any media, incorporating  
11 content identical or substantially similar to content comprising PassKey's EA  
12 Materials.

13 Defendants must disclose this Final Judgment on Consent to all of their  
14 successors and assigns.

15 The Court shall maintain jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter of  
16 this civil action for the purpose of interpreting and enforcing this Final Judgment  
17 on Consent, and the Confidential Settlement Agreement entered into separately by  
18 the parties.

19 The parties, through their undersigned counsel, hereby consent to the entry  
20 of this Final Judgment on Consent.

21 IT IS SO STIPULATED AND CONSENTED.
