The Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation on August 9, 2017, recommending that the Petition be dismissed as untimely after finding that the Petition was filed after the statute of limitations expired, and that petitioner had not set forth a credible claim of actual innocence to overcome the time bar. (Docket No. 13).

On October 2, 2017, petitioner filed an Objection to the Report and Recommendation. In
his Objection, petitioner alleges that various errors occurred with respect to his underlying criminal
investigation, trial, and sentencing. (Docket No. 16). He does not present any new reliable
evidence of actual innocence. Accordingly, after a careful review of his allegations set forth in his
Objection, the Court determines that the allegations are insufficient to show actual innocence
under Schlup v. Delo, 513 U.S. 298, 324, 329, 115 S.Ct. 851, 130 L.Ed.2d 808 (1995).
