I, BRAIDON FAVOR, LLP, US ATTORNEY STEPHANIE HONERKA, hereby declare:

1. That I am the defendant/appellant in the above-entitled cause of action.
2. That I did suffer criminal conviction on or about JULY 30, 2008,  
from the Superior Court of Los Angeles County, in Case No. BA085265-01.
3. That I hereby incorporate by reference each and every statement contained herein  
which has the box preceding same marked.
4. That I have been a resident of the State of California for approximately 35 years.
5. That I am appealing from the aforementioned conviction.
6. That I am appealing from said conviction(s) and/or sentencing will be overturned  
based on errors in law and/or constitutional grounds.

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1 answered. Whether or not the great weight of authority may support the defendant's arguments  
2 is not relevant since the arguments are significant and made in good faith.

3 Although extraordinary circumstances may be given consideration in determining  
4 whether or not a defendant should be released on either own recognizance or on bail release is  
5 not limited to those situations in which extraordinary circumstances exist. (In re Podesto, supra;  
6 In re Brumback (1955) 46 Cal.2d 810.)

7 "A court should look to the circumstances of a particular defendant, and should not adopt  
8 an ironclad, mechanical policy of denying bail to all who commit a particular crime," (In re  
9 Podesto, supra, at fn. 10; see also: In re William M. (1970) 3 Cal.3d 16; In re Minnis (1972) 7  
10 Cal.3d 639.) On the other hand, failure to consider all factors and granting or denying  
11 defendant's motion seeking release on appeal based on a politically charged atmosphere, or the  
12 trial court's abstract judgment or defendant's character violated defendant's rights to equal  
13 protection and due process. (See: Van Atta v. Scott (1980) 27 Cal.3 438; People v. Arnold  
14 (1976) 58 Cal.App.3d Supp1.)

15 The defendant herein has significant and real ties to the community. The likelihood of  
16 defendant fleeing the jurisdiction of this court is not only minimal but highly improbable. As  
17 stated in the attached declaration, there is little chance that defendant would leave all of his  
18 community, family or social relations and life contacts behind.

19 The likelihood of a defendant's flight is determined by the court by considering factors  
20 which indicate that an individual is a stable member of the community and that defendant's  
21 contacts, relationships and other ties are such that the threat of imprisonment is not likely to  
22 induce defendant to flee. Such is the case at bar.

23 It is clear the defendant's past conduct before the courts demonstrates a high probability  
24 that defendant will appear as ordered.

25 In light of the above, and the fact that defendant's sentence may very likely be fully or  
substantially served before his appeal is heard, it is respectfully requested that defendant be



1 allowed to remain free on his own recognizance or in the alternative, to remain free on appeal  
2 bond.

**INFORMATION TO PRISONERS SEEKING LEAVE TO  
PROCEED WITH A CIVIL ACTION IN FEDERAL  
COURT *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*  
PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 1915**

In accordance with 1996 amendments to the *in forma pauperis* statute, **AS A PRISONER YOU WILL BE OBLIGATED TO PAY THE FULL FILING FEE OF \$350.00 FOR A CIVIL RIGHTS ACTION, \$5.00 FOR A HABEAS CORPUS PETITION, OR \$505.00 FOR AN APPEAL. If you are not afforded *in forma pauperis* status in a Civil Rights Action, you will be required to pay the \$350.00 filing fee plus a \$50.00 administrative fee for a total of \$400.00.**

If you have the money to pay the full filing fee, send a cashier's check or money order made payable to the U.S. District Court with your complaint, petition, or notice of appeal.

If you do not have enough money to pay the full filing fee when your action is filed, you can file the action without prepaying the filing fee. The court will order the facility where you are held in custody to collect the filing fee from your prison or jail trust account. **EACH MONTH YOU WILL OWE 20 PERCENT OF YOUR PRECEDING MONTH'S INCOME TOWARD THE BALANCE UNTIL THE FILING FEE IS PAID IN FULL.** The facility will forward payments to the court any time the amount in the account exceeds \$10.00. The balance of the filing fee will be collected even if the action is later dismissed, summary judgment is granted against you, or you fail to prevail at trial. In order to proceed with an action *in forma pauperis*, you must complete the attached form and return it to the court with your complaint, habeas corpus petition, or appeal. The form includes your authorization for the agency having custody of you to provide a certified copy of your trust account statement for activity covering the last six months directly to the Court so that your eligibility for *in forma pauperis* status can be determined. Your signature on the form also authorizes the agency having custody of you to collect money from your trust account and forward it to the Clerk of the United States District Court payments if you are granted *in forma pauperis* status. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2). If you are housed at a non-CDRC facility (such as a local jail or federal facility), you must have your institution complete the certification on the form and attach a certified copy of your prison or jail account statement for the last six months.

If you submit an incomplete form or you are ineligible for *in forma pauperis* status, your request to proceed *in forma pauperis* will be denied.

The court is required to screen your complaint regardless of the amount of filing fee paid and will dismiss the complaint if:

1. Your allegation of poverty is untrue;
2. The action is frivolous or malicious;
3. Your complaint does not state a claim on which relief can be granted, or
4. You sue a defendant for money damages and that defendant is immune from liability for money damages.

If you file more than three actions or appeals while incarcerated that are dismissed as frivolous, malicious, or for failure to state a claim on which relief can be granted, you will be prohibited from bringing any other actions *in forma pauperis* unless you are in imminent danger of serious physical injury.

Appellant's January 6, 2016 motion for an extension of time to file the opening brief is denied as unnecessary. *See* 9th Cir. R. 27-11.

Appellant's motion to proceed in forma pauperis is denied because we find that the appeal is frivolous. If appellant wishes to pursue this appeal despite the court's finding that it is frivolous then, within 21 days after the date of this order, appellant shall pay \$505.00 to the district court as the docketing and filing fees for this appeal and file proof of payment with this court. Otherwise, the appeal will be

dismissed by the Clerk for failure to prosecute, regardless of further filings. *See* 9th Cir. R. 42-1.

No motions for reconsideration, clarification, or modification of the denial of appellant's in forma pauperis status shall be entertained.

Because the court has found that this appeal is frivolous, the district court judgment may be summarily affirmed even if appellant pays the fees. If appellant pays the fees and files proof of such payment in this court, appellant therefore shall simultaneously show cause why the judgment challenged in this appeal should not be summarily affirmed. *See* 9th Cir. R. 3-6. If appellant pays the fees but fails to file a response to this order, the court will determine whether to summarily affirm the judgment in this appeal based on the opening brief submitted on January 12, 2016. *See* 9th Cir. R. 42-1.

If the appeal is dismissed for failure to comply with this order, the court will not entertain any motion to reinstate the appeal that is not accompanied by proof of payment of the docketing and filing fees.

Briefing is suspended pending further order of this court.



On May 30, 2014, Brandon Favor-El ("Petitioner") filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus by a Person In State Custody, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On August 25, 2014, Petitioner filed a First Amended Petition. On January 9, 2015, Respondent filed an Answer to the First Amended Petition. On March 5, 2015, Petitioner filed a Reply to the Answer.

On October 6, 2015, Petitioner filed a "Request for Appointment by Information on Sufficient Cause to Seek Dismissal or Release Upon Bail/Own Recognizance" and a "Request for Release on Own Recognizance, Bail and/or Bond Review" (Requests for Bail), by which he seeks release from custody pending resolution of these habeas corpus proceedings.

It is unclear under Ninth Circuit law whether a federal district court has the authority to release a state prisoner pending the resolution of a habeas proceeding. See In re Roe, 257 F.3d 1077, 1080 (9th Cir. 2001) (declining to resolve the issue as to whether a district court has the authority to release a state prisoner on bail pending resolution of habeas proceedings in extraordinary cases). Yet even if a district court does have the authority to release a state prisoner while a habeas proceeding is pending, such authority is "reserved for extraordinary cases involving special circumstances or a high probability of success." Land v. Deeds, 878 F.2d 318, 318 (9th Cir. 1989). "Special circumstances" include: (i) "a serious deterioration of health while incarcerated, and unusual delay in the appeal process," Salerno v. United States, 878 F.2d 317 (9th Cir. 1987); and (ii) situations where "the sentence was so short that if bail were denied and the habeas petition were eventually granted, the defendant would already have served the sentence," Landano v. Rafferty, 970 F.2d 1230, 1239 (3rd Cir. 1992).
