Steeb, CV 17-5300 ODW (SS), Dkt. No. 54; or Hamilton v. Spears, CV 18-8762 ODW (SS), Dkt. No. 14), a copy of this Order, and a copy of the proposed complaint (or document); and (4) if the Court does not grant Plaintiff written permission to file a complaint (or document) within thirty days of the date of his Motion, permission will be deemed denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk serve a copy of this Order on Plaintiff at his current address of record.
