19	court will not rule on petitioner's request to proceed in forma pauperis.	
20	Petitioner is incarcerated in California Men's Colony and is challenging a disciplinary	
21	conviction for while an inmate at California Men's Colony for refusing to participate in	
22	programming. California Men's Colony is in an area embraced by the United States District	
23	Court for the Central District of California.	
24	Pursuant to 28 U.S.C § 2241(d), courts in both the district of conviction and the district of	
25	confinement have concurrent jurisdiction over applications for habeas corpus filed by state	
26	prisoners. Because petitioner was not convicted in this district, and is not presently confined	
27	here, this court does not have jurisdiction to entertain the application.
