On September 6, 2017, the Court ordered Joseph Katash and Jacqueline Katash (collectively, “Defendants”) to show cause why the Court should not compel Defendants to produce books, papers, records, and other data demanded in the IRS’ subpoena. (ECF No. 5.) Defendants did not respond to the Court’s order, but on October 13, 2017, the IRS filed a Notice of Compliance. (ECF No. 10.)
