Proceedings (IN CHAMBERS): ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE RE: DISMISSAL FOR LACK OF PROSECUTION

Plaintiff is ordered to show cause, in writing, no later than **March 5, 2018** why this action should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution. The Court will consider the filing of the following on or before the above date as an appropriate response to this Order to Show Cause:

- Answer by Defendant Caravan, Ltd. or an application for entry of default pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 55(a).

This is the third and final Order to Show Cause issued by the Court. The purpose of an Order to Show Cause is not to remind Plaintiff to prosecute its case. Any further failure to timely prosecute this action will result in dismissal.

No oral argument on this matter will be heard unless otherwise ordered by the Court. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 78; Local Rule 7-15. The Order will stand submitted upon the filing of the response to the Order to Show Cause. Failure to respond to the Order to Show Cause will result in the dismissal of this action.
