**JUDGMENT**

The regularly noticed Motion for Order Confirming Arbitration Award and for Entry of Judgment in Conformity Therewith of petitioner Screen Actors Guild-American Federation of Television and Radio Artists, as successor-in-interest to Screen Actors Guild, Inc. came before the Court.

Having considered all of the pleadings and arguments submitted by the parties in connection with this motion, the pleadings and papers on file, and any oral and/or documentary evidence presented at the time of hearing:

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that judgment be**

1 entered in this case as follows:

2 1. The arbitration award in favor of Screen Actors Guild-American  
3 Federation of Television and Radio Artists, as successor-in-interest to Screen  
4 Actors Guild, Inc., (“SAG-AFTRA”) and against SEPTEMBER DAWN, LLC;  
5 BLACK DIAMOND FINANCIAL GROUP, LLC; and CALIM PRIVATE  
6 EQUITY, LLC (“Respondents”), Union Case No. 8000, dated December 10, 2013,  
7 is confirmed in all respects.

8 2. Respondents are ordered to pay as follows:

9 (a) To Screen Actors Guild-American Federation of Television and  
10 Radio Artists, on behalf of affected performers, the sum of  
11 \$32,167.62;

12 (b) To Screen Actors Guild-American Federation of Television and  
13 Radio Artists for its attorney’s fees incurred in this action, the  
14 sum of \$2,400.00; and

15 (c) To Screen Actors Guild-American Federation of Television and  
16 Radio Artists for its costs incurred in this action, the sum of  
17 \$400.00.

18 3. Screen Actors Guild-American Federation of Television and Radio  
19 Artists is hereby granted an assignment of Respondents’ accounts receivable from  
20 the distribution, exhibition, exploitation or other use of the motion picture entitled  
21 “*September Dawn*” anywhere in the world until the amounts due are paid in full.

22 4. SAG-AFTRA is authorized to engage in any of the remedial actions  
23 provided for in the Security Agreement.

24 5. The parties are to split any arbitrator fees.
