1 The Applicant, the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”), having
2 filed an Application for an Order to Show Cause and an Application for Order
3 Compelling Compliance with Investigative Subpoenas against Respondents
4 Andrew T.E. Coldicutt and the Law Office of Andrew Coldicutt (collectively,
5 “Respondents”), the Court having considered the Application and documents filed
6 in support thereof, and good cause having been shown, the Court being fully
7 advised in the matter, and there being no just cause for delay:

8 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the SEC’s Application for an Order to
9 Show Cause Why an Order Compelling Compliance with Investigative Subpoenas
10 should not be issued is GRANTED.


11 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that on June 5, 2017, at

20 SEC’s Los Angeles Regional Office at 444 S. Flower Street, 9th Floor, Los
