28	Plaintiff lacks Article III standing in this matter.

2. Remand is proper based on the rationale in the Court's Order Granting 1 Plaintiffs' Request for Remand in the *Edelstein* Action, a true and correct copy of 2 which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if set forth in full 3 (the "*Edelstein* Remand Order"); 4

Defendant may remove this action to Federal Court if there is a change 5 3. in law, fact, pleadings, or briefings which would confer Federal Court jurisdiction. 6 7 Based on the foregoing, Case No. 2:18-cv-01739-AB (MRWx) is remanded to Los Angeles County Superior Court. Each party shall bear her/its own attorneys' 8 fees and costs incurred in connection with the removal of this action to Federal 9 Court and the remand to State Court. Neither Party has waived any right to 10 attorneys' fees or costs to which it is otherwise entitled to in connection with this 11 litigation. 12
