Petitioner's request for appointment of counsel (ECF No. 38 at 1) is denied. 22 23 The record does not show that the interests of justice require the appointment of 24 counsel. Rather, Petitioner has demonstrated that "he had a good understanding of the issues and the ability to present forcefully and coherently his contentions." 25 26 LaMere v. Risley, 827 F.2d 622, 626 (9th Cir. 1987) (citing Bashor v. Risley, 730 27 F.2d 1228, 1234 (9th Cir. 1984)). 28 ///
