17 Plaintiff, Monique Walters (“Plaintiff”), having accepted Defendant FCA US
18 LLC’s (“FCA” or “Defendant”) Offer of Judgment pursuant to Rule 68 of the
19 Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, submits the following Proposed Judgment.

20 1. Judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant in the
21 sum of \$32,047.47, which constitutes reimbursement for the Subject Vehicle, as
22 well as incidental and consequential damage. FCA will pay this amount within
23 seven (“7”) days after Plaintiff delivers the Subject Vehicle to Defendant.

24 2. Plaintiff will deliver the Subject Vehicle to FCA on a date, time, and
25 place mutually agreeable no later than ninety (“90”) days after August 14, 2020, the
26 date in which Plaintiff provided Notice of Acceptance of Defendant’s Rule 68
27 Offer.

28 3. Plaintiff’s attorneys’ fees and costs will be paid pursuant to Civil Code
