2	1. On August 19, 2020, Plaintiff Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. filed a Complaint		
3	for Interpleader (Dkt. 1) seeking to deposit into the Registry of this Court Interpleader		
4	Funds in the sum of \$126,448.93;		
5	2. Pursuant to this Court's Order dated October 28, 2020, Wells Fargo was
