JUDGMENT

1 The Court having granted Plaintiff’s Motion for Summary Judgment and
2 Motion for Attorneys’ Fees and Costs, it is ORDERED and ADJUDGED:
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4 1. Defendant Slauson Gas Station, LLC, a California limited liability
5 company, shall, within 120 days after the date on which this judgment is entered,
6 comply with the following requirements:
7

8 a. Defendant shall provide accessible parking at the “Sinclair Gas
9 Station,” (the “Business”) located at 4661 W. Slauson Avenue,
10 Los Angeles, CA 90043 (the “Property”) in compliance with the
11 2010 and 1991 Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility
12 Guidelines (“ADAAG”), and 2019 California Building Code
13 (“CBC”).

15 b. Defendant shall provide compliant signage regarding accessible
16 parking at the Property in accordance with the 2010 and 1991
17 ADAAG, and 2019 CBC.
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19 c. Defendant shall provide an accessible path of travel connecting
20 the designated disabled parking space, air/water machine, and the
21 public way to the business entrance on the Property in compliance
22 with the 2010 and 1991 ADAAG, and 2019 CBC.
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1 d. Defendant shall provide compliant signage at the business
2 entrance at the Property in compliance with the 2010 and 1991
3 ADAAG, and 2019 CBC.
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5 2. Judgment is entered for Plaintiff, and against Defendant in the
6 amount of \$8,000 for statutory damages under the Unruh Act.
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8 3. Plaintiff is awarded \$15,127.80 for attorneys' fees and \$2,050.10 for
9 costs.
