No. 51, it is: 19 ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Defendants Sedgwick Claims Management 20 Services, Inc. (Sedgwick) and AT&T Services, Inc. (AT&T) abused their discretion in 21 concluding that Plaintiff Lisa Mosqueda was not disabled for the period of January 1, 22 2020 through April 30, 2020. It is further 23 ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Defendants did not abuse their discretion 24 in concluding that Plaintiff was not disabled for the remainder of the time period at 25 issue—September 17, 2019 through December 31, 2019 and May 1, 2020 through 26 June 15, 2020. It is further 27 ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Defendants shall pay Plaintiff short-term 28
