With respect to service of individuals and/or business entities in a foreign country, plaintiff shall exercise all reasonable diligence and attempt service within the 90-day time period. Accordingly, the court, on its own motion, orders plaintiff(s) to show cause in writing on or before November 29, 2024 , why this action should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution.
