Proceedings: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

- By Plaintiffs: Proofs of Service of the Summons and Complaint on every Defendant.

AND/OR

- By Defendants: Responses to the Complaint. The parties may also file an appropriate stipulation to extend the time within which Defendant must respond to the Complaint.

OR

- By Plaintiffs: Applications to the Clerk to Enter Default as to properly served Defendants who have not timely responded to the Complaint.

No oral argument on this matter will be heard unless otherwise ordered by the Court. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 78; Local Rule 7-15. The Order will stand

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submitted upon the filing of the response to the Order to Show Cause. Failure to respond to the Order to Show Cause by **JUNE 20, 2025**, will result in the dismissal of this action.
