

18 Pursuant to the Order Adopting Findings, Conclusions, and
19 Recommendations of United States Magistrate Judge,
20

21 IT IS ADJUDGED that the Petition For Writ of Habeas Corpus is
22 GRANTED as follows: The Board's August 27, 2003 decision finding
23 Petitioner suitable for parole is reinstated. Within thirty (30) days,
24 the Board shall calculate a parole release date for Petitioner in
25 accordance with California law. If the release date has passed,
26 Respondent shall, within ten (10) days after the parole release date is
27 calculated, either release Petitioner from custody, if the release date
28 lapsed more than three years earlier, or release Petitioner on parole,

1 subject to the conditions of parole imposed at his August 27, 2003
2 hearing, for that period of his three-year parole term that remains if
3 the release date lapsed less than three years earlier.
