PROCEEDINGS: MINUTE ORDER REMANDING CASE TO THE SUPERIOR
COURT OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA COUNTY OF
SAN BERNARDINO FOR LACK OF SUBJECT MATTER
JURISDICTION (IN CHAMBERS)

On June 11, 2008, Plaintiff GRP Loan, LLC filed an action for unlawful detainer against defendants Raymundo Corral and Rafael Orozco ("Defendants") in the California Superior Court for the County of San Bernardino. Defendants removed the action to this Court on September 11, 2008, without sufficiently alleging subject matter jurisdiction. The Court issued an Order to Show Cause for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction on October 6, 2008. The Court has received and considered Defendants' responses to the Court's Order to Show Cause.

A case shall be remanded when the court lacks subject matter jurisdiction.
