1 The United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit's Judgment in this
2 matter, entered June 22, 2012 and amended November 5, 2012, took effect, pursuant
3 to the issuance of the Mandate, on November 20, 2013.

4 Pursuant to that Mandate, IT IS ADJUDGED THAT Judgment shall be
5 entered granting petitioner's habeas corpus petition, and requiring respondent to
6 release petitioner within 45 days of the entry of this Judgment unless the San
7 Bernardino County Superior Court, within that time period, vacates Mr. Johnson's
8 conviction, guilty plea, and plea agreement in Case No. FWV035414, and the matter
9 be calendared for trial within the applicable statutory time, or a new plea agreement
10 be reached between Mr. Johnson and the state.
