PROCEEDINGS: (IN CHAMBERS)

On February 18, 2011, this Court issued an Order giving plaintiff until March 10, 2011, to file a First Amended Complaint. The Order expressly admonished plaintiff that, if he failed to timely file a First Amended Complaint, or in the alternative, submit the previously-ordered documents for service by the U.S. Marshal's office of the original Complaint, the Court would recommend that the action be dismissed for failure to prosecute and follow court orders. Accordingly, **no later than April 21, 2011, plaintiff is ordered to show cause** why this case should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute and follow court orders. Filing of the First Amended Complaint, or submission of the ordered documents to the U.S. Marshal on or before April 21, 2011, shall be deemed compliance with this Order to Show Cause. Plaintiff's failure to comply with this Order shall result in the Court recommending that this action be dismissed.
