U.S.C. § 1441(a); see Exxon Mobil Corp v. Allapattah Svcs., Inc., 545 U.S. 546, 563, 125 S. Ct. 2611, 162 L. Ed. 2d 502 (2005). Here, defendant asserted diversity jurisdiction as his basis for removal, in that he cited to 28 U.S.C. § 1332 and alleged the amount in controversy exceeds \$75,000. But as described in more detail in the Order Denying Defendant's Request to Proceed Without Prepayment of Filing Fee, because neither the Notice of Removal nor the underlying Complaint alleges diversity of citizenship, there is no basis to assert diversity jurisdiction. See 28 U.S.C. §§ 1332, 1441. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that: (1) this matter be REMANDED to the Superior Court of California, Riverside County, 4050 Main Street, Riverside, CA 92501, for lack of subject matter jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1447(c); (2) that the Clerk send a certified copy of this Order to the state court; and (3) that the Clerk serve copies of this Order on the parties. 4/26/2014 DATED:
