ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE REGARDING PLAINTIFF'S FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH SCHEDULING ORDER AND TO FILE STATUS REPORT

On January 30, 2018, this Court issued a Case Management and Scheduling Order ("Case Management Order") which directed each party, <u>inter alia</u>, to file and serve a status report no later than March 30, 2018. <u>See</u> Case Management Order, ¶ 10. Although defendant timely filed such a status report, plaintiff did not do so. To date, plaintiff has failed to file a status report or to seek an extension of time to do so.

IT IS ORDERED that the plaintiff shall show cause in writing, on or before **May 8, 2018**, as to why monetary sanctions or other disciplinary measures as deemed appropriate, including dismissal of the case for failure to prosecute should not be imposed for failure to file a timely status report as called for by the Case Management Order.

Plaintiff is cautioned that the failure to comply with this order and/or to show good cause, may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this action for failure to prosecute.
