ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

By Order filed June 29, 2015, defendant was ordered to serve and file a responsive pleading to the Complaint within 120 days from the date of service. Plaintiff has filed a proof of service of the summons and complaint indicating that service was effected on June 3, 2015 in compliance with Rule 4(i) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
