Petitioner also moves to stay decision in this action 1 pursuant to Rhines v. Weber, 544 U.S. 269 (2005), so that he may 2 3 return to state court to exhaust additional claims not raised in 4 his Petition. (Dkt. No. 58). Having reviewed Petitioner's Motion to Stay, the Court concludes that Petitioner has not 5 demonstrated that the Court should exercise its discretion to б 7 stay this action. See Rhines, 544 U.S. at 277 (stay and abeyance 8 is available only in "limited circumstances" where habeas petitioner demonstrates good cause for failure to exhaust claims 9 10 in state court and where unexhausted claims are not plainly 11 meritless). Petitioner's Motion to Stay is therefore denied. 12 13 IT IS ORDERED that the Petition is denied and Judgment shall 14 be entered dismissing this action with prejudice. 15 16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk serve copies of this 17 Order and the Judgment herein on Petitioner and on counsel for 18 Respondent. 19 20 LET JUDGMENT BE ENTERED ACCORDINGLY. 21 22 DATED: December 19, 2016 am n 23 JOHN A.
