
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

1 Based on the stipulation and declaration of Plaintiff's counsel filed by the
2 parties on April 21, 2016 and good cause appearing, the Court hereby orders this case
3 dismissed with prejudice as to Plaintiff Adam Coronado as to all claims in his
4 Complaint, including his claim under the Fair Labor Standards Act, with each party to
5 bear their own attorney's fees and costs. The claims of the putative class and any
6 alleged collective action claims are dismissed without prejudice.
