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In ¶ 1 of its Order re Further Proceedings, the Court ordered the parties to file separate briefs regarding the issues on appeal. Plaintiff’s memorandum in support of the complaint (not to exceed a total of 25 pages (Local Rule 11-6)) was due within **35 days** from the filing of the Court’s Order, *i.e.*, February 10, 2017.

More than forty-five (45) days from the filing of the Court’s Order has elapsed, and plaintiff has not filed a memorandum in support of the complaint showing compliance with ¶ 1 of the Order re Further Proceedings.

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1           Accordingly, on or before March 10, 2017, plaintiff is ORDERED to either (a)  
2 show good cause in writing, if any exists, why the Court should not recommend that  
3 this case be dismissed for lack of diligent prosecution and/or failure to comply with  
4 the Court's prior Order; or (b) file her memorandum in support of the complaint, as  
5 well as a proof of service reflecting such service.
