1 **JUDGMENT**

2 On October 14, 2016, Plaintiffs Broadcast Music, Inc., Del Sound Music, MJ
3 Publishing Trust d/b/a Mijac Music; Welsh Witch Music, Rondor Music
4 International, Inc. d/b/a Irving Music, Underachiever Music, Songs of Universal,
5 Inc., Escatawpa Songs, Warner-Tamerlane Publishing Corp., Average Joe’s
6 Entertainment Group LLC d/b/a Average ZJs Music Publishing and Indiana Angel
7 Music (collectively, “Plaintiffs”) filed a motion for default judgment against
8 Defendants Anchor Ventures and Benedict Seelhofer.


9 No opposition having been made thereto, on November 17, 2016, the Court
10 granted the Motion for Default Judgment.

11 The Court hereby grants judgment as follows.

12 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiffs
13 recover, jointly and severally, the amount of \$28,119.12 (consisting of \$25,200 in
14 statutory damages, \$2,280 in attorney fees, and \$639.12 in costs): Plaintiffs shall
15 recover from Defendants Anchor Ventures and Benedict Seelhofer, jointly and
16 severally, interest on the full amount of this judgment, from the date of this
17 judgment, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. Section 1961.

18 Defendants Anchor Ventures and Benedict Seelhofer and their agents,
19 servants, employees and all persons acting under their permission or authority shall
20 be PERMANENTLY ENJOINED AND RESTRAINED from infringing, in any
21 manner, the copyrighted musical compositions licensed by Broadcast Music, Inc.
