PROCEEDINGS (IN CHAMBERS): ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

In the Declaration of Steven M. Dailey re: Attempted Compliance with L.R. 7-3 and Standing Order 5(b) filed on February 16, 2017 [Docket No. 17], counsel represents that Plaintiff Champan R. Washington ("Plaintiff") failed to respond to Defendant's efforts to comply with Local Rule 7-3.
