The Court has reviewed the Second Amended Complaint, records on file, and Report and Recommendation of U.S. Magistrate Judge. See 28 U.S.C. § 636. On October 12, 2017, Plaintiff filed objections to the R. & R., and on October 26 Defendants Stephanie Vanegas, Waleska Stanford, and Raquel Madrigal filed a response. Plaintiff for the most part simply repeats, verbatim, arguments made in his opposition to Defendants' motion to dismiss. arguments were thoroughly addressed in the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation.

Having made a de novo determination of those portions of the R. & R. to which Plaintiff objected, the Court accepts the findings and recommendations of the Magistrate Judge. THEREFORE IS ORDERED that Defendants' motion to dismiss the Second Amended Complaint without leave to amend is GRANTED, the

claims against the nonmoving Defendants are dismissed without leave to amend, and judgment be entered for all Defendants.
