Pursuant to the Court's Order of August 28, 2017, the parties were required to complete a settlement conference before the assigned magistrate judge no later than February 26, 2018 (See Dkt. 16 at 17). If the case settled, the parties were required to file a Notice of Settlement no later than 24 hours after settlement. (See id.). Otherwise, the parties were required to file a Status Report Re: Settlement no later than 48 hours after the settlement conference was complete. (See id.). As of the filling date of this Order, neither a Notice of Settlement nor a Status Report Re Settlement has been filed. (See, generally, Dkt.). Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT, no late than March 9, 2018, the parties shall show cause in writing why sanctions should not be imposed for failure to comply with the Court's Order of August 28, 2017. Failure to submit a response to this Order by the deadline set forth above may result in the imposition of sanctions and/or dismissal of this action for lack of prosecution. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b); Link v Wabash R.R. Co., 370 U.S. 626, 629-30, 82 S.Ct. 1386, 1388 (1962); Pagtalunan v. Galaza, 297 F.3d 639, 642 (9th Cir. 2002), cert. denied, 538 U.S. 909 (2003).							
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
