On May 24, 2018, Plaintiff Christopher Fearon, a detainee at the Central Detention Center, filed a First Amended Complaint under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. [Dkt. No. 12]. PROSECUTE AND OBEY COURT ORDERS

Plaintiff must file a written response by no later than **October 25, 2019**. Plaintiff may respond to this Order to Show Cause by (a) filing a Second Amended Complaint; or (b) filing a statement with the Court indicating the desire to continue to move forward with the First Amended Complaint despite the weaknesses noted by the Court in the Order Dismissing First Amended Complaint with Leave to Amend.

Plaintiff is expressly warned that failure to timely file a response to this Order to Show Cause may result in a recommendation to the District Judge that this action be
