3	entered substantially contemporaneously herewith, and in accordance with
4	Rules 55 and 58 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure,
5	It is hereby <b>ORDERED</b> , <b>ADJUDGED</b> , and <b>DECREED</b> as follows:
6	1. This Court possesses subject-matter jurisdiction over this action
7	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1331 and 18 U.S.C. § 1964(c).
8	2. On or about March 4, 2021, Plaintiffs Heredia Boxing
9	Management, Inc. and Moses Heredia voluntarily <b>DISMISSED</b> Defendants
10	VGC, LLP and Golden Boy Productions, Inc. as parties in this case.
11	3. On or about April 11, 2022, the Court <b>DISMISSED</b> Plaintiff
12	Heredia Boxing Management, Inc. as a party in this case.
13	4. The operative pleading is the Third Amended Complaint [ECF
14	No. 85] filed by Plaintiff Moses Heredia.
15	5. On or about September 6, 2022, the Court <b>DISMISSED without</b>
16	prejudice all of the claims of Plaintiff Moses Heredia against Defendant Golden
17	Boy Promotions, Inc.
18	6. Plaintiff Moses Heredia shall have <b>JUDGMENT</b> in his <b>FAVOR</b> ,
19	and AGAINST Defendants MTK Global Sports Management, LLC; Paul D.
20	Gibson; Daniel Kinahan; and MTK Global USA, LLC, jointly and severally, in
21	the total amount of <b>\$9,731,248.61</b> (which sum consists of \$9,517,500 in treble
22	damages; \$193,950 in attorney's fees; and \$19,798.61 in costs).
23	7. To the extent that any party requests any other form of relief, such
24	request is <b>DENIED</b> .
