**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY SANCTIONS SHOULD  
NOT BE IMPOSED FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH  
THE COURT'S ORDER**

In the Court's Scheduling and Case Management Order ("CMO"), the Court set January 9, 2023 as the last day to conduct a Settlement Conference, and January 13, 2023 as the last day to file a Joint Report Re: Results of Settlement Conference. Based on the Joint Status Report of Settlement Conference/Mediation, it appears that the parties have violated the Court's CMO by failing to complete the Settlement Conference by the Court ordered deadline of January 9, 2023.

Accordingly, lead counsel for the parties are ordered to show cause in writing by **January 20, 2023** why the Court should not dismiss this action or impose sanctions in the amount of \$2,500.00 against each lead counsel for violating the Court's CMO. No oral argument on this matter will be heard unless otherwise ordered by the Court. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 78; Local Rule 7-15. The Order to Show Cause will stand submitted upon the filing of the response to the Order to Show Cause. Failure to respond to the Order to Show Cause will result in the dismissal of this action and imposition of sanctions.
